"Regina Pacis" Foundation in Moldova, later on the "Foundation", is created as a result of the reorganization through the transformation of the "Regina Pacis" Foundation's branch in Moldova. The foundation is the successor of the "Regina Pacis" Foundation branch in Moldova regarding the rights and obligations.

The **Foundation** is an organization of public utility, non-political, non-commercial, created by the Episcopacy of Roman Catholic Church in the Republic of Moldova and aims to provide moral aid, assistance and social reintegration to all those who are in difficult conditions, and in particular lonely children, men and women in need, trafficked women, poor, Moldovan citizens who immigrated.

The Foundation's mission is to contribute to solving complex problems of the society by providing moral and financial aid, assistance and social reintegration of all those who are in difficult conditions, and in particular lonely children, men and women in need, trafficked women, poor, Moldovan citizens who immigrated.

The basic **goals** of the Foundation are:

- recovery, receipt and reintegration of victims of trafficking, in addition to information about the risks of involvement in illegal migration forms;
- assistance for people of any age living in conditions of poverty, through the distribution of humanitarian goods, food and everything they may need to improve their condition;
- assistance for minors living in difficult conditions by placing them in homes-families, reintegration into the family of origin and the structures of the territory, accompanying them to school and everything that may be necessary for their development;
- assistance for families, especially for those where there are serious poverty conditions;
- support and help in developing pastoral activities, catechism, Christian education, charitable activities and missionary services for the faithful of the Episcopacy of Roman Catholic Church in Moldova, and for others, on their wish;
- legal assistance and legal information for all the assisted subjects;



- joint implementation together with the organs, bodies and authorities of the European Union and Council of Europe of various programs related to the goals and tasks of the Foundation.

Beneficiaries: the disabled, victims of the phenomenon of trafficking in human beings (the TFB), orphans, children of the street, children from socially vulnerable families, single-parent families, families from the risk group, the elderly, youth, adolescents, teachers, parents, representatives of national minorities and people of different religious denominations.

From Regina Pacis Foundation's experience:

A team of managers and professionally-trained facilitators activate within the Foundation.

The Foundation conducts the following activities:



- Medical and psychological assistance, counseling of children without parental protection by the employees and specialists of the Placement Center for Children under Regina Pacis Foundation, where 16 children without parental protection have been currently placed. Hosting the children in the Placement Center with all it implies (conditions of accommodation and meals, general atmosphere, the relationship specialized personnel - child, etc.);
- Financial support for the children from the risk group families, by providing schooling, kindergarten, paying the fees for kindergarten and school, ensuring regular food, clothing, medicines, school supplies, toys, gifts for holidays and birthdays, organizing children's holidays in summer camps, etc.. Currently around 80 families from the risk group have been provided for;
- Assistance for the people in need, lonely elderly, disabled, through the distribution of daily hot lunches to about 250 beneficiaries daily in the three distribution points (two points in Chisinau City and one in the county of Florești). Regular distribution of food packages to the people in need, footwear, clothing, medicines, etc.;
- In collaboration with Fondazione Regina Pacis Italy provision of aid to persons subjected to human trafficking, provision of medical and psychological assistance in their recovery and reintegration into society, in special cases, repatriation and reintegration into the biological family;
- Conduct of prevention and mass-information programs of the young generation and the population about the risks of illegal migration, the consequences of human trafficking; training of facilitators and volunteers from among adolescents and young people from the risk group, and representatives of the decision factors of the Local Public Administration of the territory etc.;
- Edition and free distribution of informative materials, videos, radio and TV transmissions, articles in newspapers about the conduct of Programs and achievements of Regina Pacis Foundation etc.

Thematic campaigns:

Conducting the thematic Campaign "Say NO to trafficking" with the generic "Your dignity is in your hands - Keep it!", with the financial support of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Italy, between 2003 – 2006.
